2. Rides & Entertainment

Gilpin County Fair is interested in having the following rides and entertainment:

- Elevated ropes/obstacle course
- Bungee trampoline- 4 person (such as the euro or salto trampoline)
- Mechanical bull
- R/C off road cars
- Mobile ninja course
- Giant, 2-lane dry slide inflatable
- Stunt jump/drop off inflatable
- Water walker balls
- Bounce house- small

Rides and entertainment will operate:

- Saturday, July 11 from 10:00am-7:00pm
- Sunday, July 12 from 8:00am-3:00pm

Please note: only a portion of the rides/entertainment will be selected due to budget limitations.

3. Service/Requirements

Contractor:

- a. In your proposal, please include costs for all attendants needed.
- b. Must carry public liability and property damage liability Insurance with “Gilpin County” as additional named insured in the amount of \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000.

- c. Must not employ illegal aliens.
- d. Must have workers compensation insurance coverage for all employees.

Gilpin County Fair may provide:

- a. Lodging cabins for attendants.
- b. Electrical power for rides.

4. Submission Guidelines

Proposals must include:

- a. What rides/entertainment you are able to provide.
- b. Pricing for each ride/attraction, including attendant cost.
- c. Reference- at least 2 references (past clients).

Proposals must be submitted in writing and received no later than **5:00 p.m. March 20, 2020.**
